

Dress Code

KIDS TAP AND BALLET KIDS JAZZ AND BALLET COMBINATION CLASSES

Any combination of leotard, tights, leggings, tutus, tshirts and dance shorts. No jeans/jean shorts.

ALL: Black Tap Shoes

GIRLS: Pink Ballet Shoes (leather or canvas)

BOYS: Black Ballet Shoes (leather or canvas)

BALLET PRIMARY-ADVANCED

GIRLS: Light pink ballet shoes, light pink footed tights, solid royal blue leotard (any style).

BOYS: Black ballet shoes, black footed tights or leggings (belt or compression shorts if needed), fitted, solid black or royal blue tee or tank, tucked in.

OPTIONAL: Black or royal blue chiffon ballet skirts may be allowed at the discretion of the teacher. Ballet sweaters and leg warmers may be worn during the winter months. No shorts.

Pre -pointe and pointe shoes are allowed for students over the age of 12, ONLY after dancer evaluation and studio authorization.

JAZZ, HIPHOP, TAP PRIMARY-ADVANCED

Any combination of fitted, stretchy clothing, including leggings, unitards, leotards, dance pants, dance shorts.

JAZZ ALL: Tan jazz shoes (leather or canvas)

HIPHOP ALL: Clean sneakers.

DIRTY SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE STUDIO FLOORS.

TAP ALL: Black tap shoes (Capezio or Bloch recommended)

CONTEMPORARY PRIMARY-ADVANCED

Any combination of fitted, stretchy clothing, including leggings, unitards, leotards, dance pants, dance shorts.

ALL: Bare foot or half soles

Advanced students may wear dance socks as approved by instructor

**Hair must be secured, neatly, out the the dancer's face.
Dancers dressed inappropriately may be asked to leave class.**
