



SCHEDULE

- Yosemite Dance Company is a private school, offering dance classes, year-round, in Oakhurst, California.
 Annual Session August 18, 2025-June xx, 2026 Recital occurs at the end of the session.
 Summer Session (new class schedule) June xx, 2026 through July xx, 2026
- The studio closes for selected holidays.
- Holiday dates are posted in the studio and on our website, www.yosemitedancecompany.net.
- Classes not meeting minimum enrollment levels may be closed, combined with other classes, or cancelled.
- Classes cancelled for safety reasons such as inclement weather or natural disasters, will be rescheduled, up to two weeks. In the event the studio must be closed for more than two weeks, instruction will move online for a period of one month. For extended closures, please refer to our PUBLIC HEALTH POLICY, provided, and posted on our website.

FEES

- A non-refundable studio registration fee, \$75/dancer, is assessed annually and is payable in August or upon the date of enrollment for Season Eleven, the 2025-2026 Annual Session.
- Monthly tuition (see Tuition Chart on the bottom of the Schedule of Classes) is payable on the 1st of each month and is considered past due upon close-of-business on the 5th of each month.
- A \$20.00 late charge will be assessed to unpaid accounts on the 6th of the month. We do not send bills.**
- Fees may be paid by cash or check at the front desk.
- Monthly tuition is not based upon the number of classes in any given month, as that number will vary. The *only* time monthly tuition is pro-rated is when a new student begins mid-month and will have fewer than 4 classes in that month.
- Tuition is not adjusted due to holidays, breaks, or absences.
- Dancers requesting a leave of absence are expected to maintain their YDC registration through the payment of tuition, as usual, during their leave. Missed classes may be made up upon their return.
- Unless arrangements are made with management, enrollment will terminate administratively for accounts 60 days past due (see Drop Policy).
- Dishonored checks will be charged a \$30.00 fee.
- The Drop-in rate to sample a single class is \$25.00, payable on the day of the class, prior to the start of the class.
- Private classes are by arrangement only and are contingent upon studio and teacher availability. Fees will be discussed prior to scheduling private classes. Cancellation of scheduled private classes requires 24-hour notice; otherwise, the dancer is liable for the full payment.
- Tuition is an annual amount. It is divided into 10 monthly payments.
- Monthly tuition costs are found in the chart at the bottom of the Schedule of Classes.
- Refer to the Tuition Chart for discounts given to dancers enrolling in multiple classes.

RECITAL

- The annual recital will take place on Saturday, June xx, 2026. More information will be provided as plans develop.
- Recital costumes are \$75.00/class for child sizes, and \$85.00/class for adult sizes. Accessories, except shoes and tights, are included in the price.
- Costume costs are payable on November 1, 2026. A \$20.00 late fee/costume will be applied to accounts not paid in full by November 10, 2026.
- Costume payments are non-refundable.
- Alterations, if needed, are the responsibility of the parent.
- The recital fee, \$75.00/dancer, is due April 1, 2026. The fee includes 4 show tickets and the finale tee-shirt.
- The recital fee is non-refundable.
- A \$20.00 late fee is added if paid after April 15, 2026.
- Recital participation for those enrolling after January 1, 2026, is contingent upon costume availability.
- Parents may purchase a digital video download of the recital performance.

MISSED CLASSES/DROPPING A CLASS

- Enrollment is for the entire session; enrollment through recital.
- Tuition is not pro-rated due to missed classes. Missed classes will not be considered credit towards future tuition payments. YDC does not offer tuition refunds of any kind.
- It is the responsibility of the parent to schedule make up classes within 30 days of the missed class. Make-up classes are not permitted for scheduled or imposed studio closures.
- Dropping a class, or terminating YDC enrollment, requires 30 days written notice. Tuition must be paid for the final 30-day period, during which time the dancer is encouraged to continue participating in the class.** Drop cards are available at the front desk.
- Tuition and late fees will continue to accrue for one month following any withdrawal without 30 days written notice.**

TERMINATION OF ENROLLMENT/RE-ENROLLMENT FOLLOWING TERMINATION

1. Following a 30-day absence without prior written notice, the dancer's space in the class is forfeited, and YDC enrollment is terminated administratively.
2. Re-enrollment, following either voluntary or administrative termination, requires payment of any prior outstanding balance. Prior credit balances may be applied if re-enrollment occurs within 12 months of the termination.

PUBLIC HEALTH/MANDATED CLOSURE POLICY

1. Yosemite Dance Company will comply with all government recommendations that may be issued as the result of Public Health emergencies, such as the 2020-21 business shut down due to the Covid19 pandemic. Specific re-opening policies will be set and communicated to all enrolled dancers.

GENERAL

1. Yosemite Dance Company is not responsible for injuries, or illnesses, that may occur during classes, rehearsals, or other activities conducted on or off the premises.
2. Childcare is NOT provided by the studio. Please do not leave dancers or siblings of dancers or friends of dancers unattended at the studio.
3. Dancers should come to class with a full water bottle and snacks, especially if they are taking multiple classes in one day. Water and snacks are available for purchase, at \$1.00 each. . Dancers may "charge" water and snacks, if unprepared to pay. Parents will be billed at the end of each month.

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
